To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.			
We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Open an Account or Wire Transfer ▪ Apply for Financing or Give us your Contact Information ▪ Make Deposits or Withdraws from your Account We also collect your personal information from others, such as the credit bureau and other companies.			
Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness ▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.			
Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Niagara Frontier Federal Municipal Employees Credit Union has no affiliates</i> 			
Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Niagara Frontier Federal Municipal Employees Credit Union does not share with our non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i> 			
A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Niagara Frontier Federal Municipal Employees Credit Union doesn't participate in Joint Marketing</i>
